TDI NEW ENGLAND'S STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH PSB RULE 5.402(B) – NOTICE TO ADJOINING LANDOWNERS

Champlain VT, LLC d/b/a TDI New England ("TDI-NE"), by and through its attorneys Dunkiel Saunders Elliott Raubvogel & Hand, PLLC, hereby attests to the following, in accordance with Public Service Board ("Board") Rule 5.402(B):

Individual Notice to Adjoining Landowners

Concurrent with the filing of TDI-NE's Section 248 Petition in the above-referenced proceeding, TDI-NE has provided written notice of the NECPL to almost 700 adjoining property owners who either: (i) share a boundary with the right-of-way on which the proposed transmission cables for the NECPL will be located; or (ii) would share a boundary with the right-of-way but for the presence of a river, stream, public highway, or railroad line; or (iii) with respect to other NECPL transmission facilities not part of the transmission line, shares a boundary with the tract of land on which the Converter Station will be located, or would share a boundary line with the Converter Station but for the presence of a river,

To identify adjoining landowners, representatives of TDI-NE visited the town offices in the Towns of Alburgh, Benson, Castleton, Cavendish, Clarendon, Fair Haven, Ira, Ludlow, Mount Holly, Rutland, Shrewsbury, Wallingford, West Haven, and West Rutland, and collected information from the town officials at each office. Between November 12th and 18th, 2014, a TDI-NE representative consulted town tax maps for the relevant areas in which the NECPL will be located and compared these against each town's certified Grand List as it existed no more than 60 days prior to the date notice was provided. Notice letters were sent to the mailing address on the Grand List for each of the adjoining properties.

Voluntary General Notice

TDI-NE intends to provide general notice to the general public in the towns and regions that adjoin Lake Champlain in Vermont, New York, and Canada.¹ This voluntary general notice will be provided in the next few weeks via publication of a notice in local and regional newspapers (including on-line) in those areas. TDI-NE anticipates publishing notice in numerous newspapers and weeklies and on-line media with a combined circulation of hundreds of thousands of readers. After publication occurs, TDI-NE will inform the Board of the publications utilized and the dates of publication.
